



Timber Products - Chain of Custody Schemes

Percentage Claims

Our suppliers producing Certified Product do so under various certification schemes, each of which operates their own rules, and separate Chain of Custody schemes.

To give Chain of Custody on all accepted Certified Product we operate three Chain of custody schemes

Under each of these schemes individual producers can make differing claims and will label their product accordingly. It would be impossible to document all variations. Therefore the claims we make under our Chain of Custody reflect the minimum standards permitted, although in practice the actual certified percentages may be higher.

PEFC Minimum 70% Raw Material Content is Certified

Elliottis Plywood

FSC Minimum 70% Raw Material Content is Certified

Tropical Hardwood Plywood

MTCC Minimum 70% Raw Material Content is Certified
 FSC Minimum 70% Raw Material Content is Certified

In the case of Manufactured Sheet Materials suppliers may also make claims as to the Post-consumer recycled content
