

BUILD YOUR OWN BBQ

What you'll need:

- Bricks x 247
- Jewson Ballast x 8 Handy Bags
- Building Sand x 5 Handy Bags
- MoT Type 1 Sub Base Handy Bags x 7
- Cement x 3
- Metal grill
- 10 metal ties



1 Mark out the area where the BBQ is to be sited and dig out the vegetation to a depth of 150mm.

2 Fill the excavation with the Limestone sub base to a depth of 100mm and compact till hard and level.

3 Mix the concrete and pore over the limestone again to a depth 100mm making sure it is level as the brickwork will be sitting on this base.

4 Build up the brickwork sides and back to 9 course high all the way round.

5 Insert the metal ties in the bed joint on both sides, 2 per side and one in the centre at the back, the ones on the side 50mm from the front and back, this is to hold the grill for the charcoal.

6 Build another 2 courses, which will be 1 course from the finished height.

7 Insert 5 more metal ties to hold the cooking grill.

8 Lay final course of bricks on their edge to give a finished feel to the top of the BBQ.
